
Our Mission

Soroptimist is a global volunteer organization that provides women and girls with access to the education and training they need to achieve personal and economic empowerment.

Soroptimist International of Los Angeles' membership consists of volunteers who create, conduct, develop, and/or support programs that promote the health, safety, and personal and professional growth of women and girls.

SI of Los Angeles was chartered on July 19, 1922. We incorporated in the State of California in 1947 and received our 501(c)3 designation in 1949.

Soroptimist International of the Americas has set an amazing goal - to invest in the dreams of half a million women and girls through our Dream programs. That's four times our current reach!

Realizing half a million big dreams will have an incredible impact on women, their families, their communities, and the world. It has been shown that a quality education - more than any other intervention or solution - holds the greatest potential to transform the lives of women and their children.

SI of Los Angeles is proud to participate in Dream It, Be It Career Support for Girls. Since 2015, Dream It, Be It has given more than 84,000 girls worldwide the tools they need to achieve their education and career goals. 88% of former participants report feeling more confident about their future success. 86% report feeling more prepared to pursue their career goals, and 91% feel they created achievable goals for their future.

This year SI of Los Angeles collaborated with Sacred Heart High School. We explored topics such as discovering your dreams, exploring careers, creating achievable goals, rising above obstacles, and balancing stress with more than 300 participants.







Soroptimists' Live Your Dream Awards program is a unique education award for women who provide the primary financial support for their families. The Live Your Dream Awards give women the resources they need to improve their education, skills, and employment prospects.

Over half of our Live Your Dream Awards recipients are survivors of domestic violence, trafficking or sexual assault. Nearly all of the women and families we serve have overcome enormous obstacles including poverty, teen pregnancy, and drug or alcohol addiction. Live Your Dream Awards recipients may use the cash award to offset any costs associated with their efforts to attain higher education, such as books, childcare, tuition and transportation.

For Women in Graduate Studies

2023-2024 Recipients

SI of Los Angeles is proud to have offered our graduate fellowship award since 1947. The Joan Johnson Fellowship Award for Women in Graduate Studies is awarded annually to an outstanding graduate student.

Applicants must be female or identify as female, and be enrolled in a graduate degree program at an accredited institution of higher education in Los Angeles County. Candidates must also have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, and 3 letters of reference. The field of study is open, but consideration is given to candidates who have higher financial need and a history of contributing through volunteer efforts with particular attention to the betterment of women and girls.



Downtown Women's Center is the only organization in Los Angeles focused exclusively on serving and empowering women experiencing homelessness and formerly homeless women. SI of Los Angeles is proud to support Downtown Women's Center's efforts.

Our members enjoy donating our time and skills by participating in Downtown Women's Center Cooking Club where we sponsor and prepare a meal for 150 women several times a year.























Since 1932, Soroptimist International of Los Angeles has been proud to lay claim to a little corner of Griffith Park, the Soroptimist Grove. This beautiful spot in the Ferndell area of Griffith Park boasts picnic tables and BBQs, and is located close to the Trails cafe and a children's playground.

In honor of our 100th Birthday, SI of Los Angeles and the Friends of Griffith Park have donated beautiful new BBQs and picnic tables for the Soroptimist Grove.

Soroptimist International of Los Angeles kicks off our club year with a planning retreat in August. We are active from September through June each year, with two meetings a month from 6:00-8:00 pm on the first and third Wednesday of each month.

Dues

Soroptimist International of the Americas (SIA) is our Federation, which consists of clubs in North America, Latin America, and the Pacific Rim. A member of SI of Los Angeles, Ginger Cole, is the current President for Soroptimist International of the Americas! Soroptimist International consists of five federations worldwide.

Camino Real Region (CRR) is our Region. Our Region consists of 22 clubs in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties.

Annual dues are collected each spring. Dues paid support programs (such as the Dream Programs) for our local club, Soroptimist International of Los Angeles, as well as our Region and Federation. Dues are prorated for members joining after January 1st.

Founders Pennies are an optional annual donation to celebrate the founding of our organization and support the global Dream Programs. Founders Pennies are set at \$0.06 per member times the number of years that Soroptimist has been in existence.
